



### Maths

This term, children will continue to develop their understanding of measure:

- **Money and time**
- **Length and temperature**
- **Volume and mass**

They will also continue to develop their 'resilience' and 'thinking' through problem solving and reasoning.

### Mandarin

### Computing

Children will develop skills in two units:

- **Researching** to collaborate and build a presentation
- **Using emails** to communicate and how to stay safe online will be reinforced

### Music

Children will explore ways in which The Bible is important for Christians.

### Science

Children will explore two different units of work:

- **Light and shadows** – investigating the wonders of light

### English

Children will explore narrative writing and produce two narratives, an information leaflet and a letter

In reading lessons children will explore texts connected to rivers and mountains, fairy tales and poetry.

The grammar focus this term will be:

- **Adjectives, nouns and verbs**
- **Using determiners**

### Physical Education

Two disciplines will be taught this term:
