



Maths

In Maths we will be building on our knowledge and understanding of the following:

- **Fractions, decimals and percentages**
- **Ratio and proportion**
- **Geometry** – properties of shape and position and movement

We will continue to build maths fluency and apply the above skills to problem solving and reasoning in order to improve children's 'thinking' and 'resilience'

Science

In Science we will be growing our skills in 'working scientifically through the following units:

- **Evolution and inheritance**
- **Healthy bodies** – the circulatory system

History

In History we will be studying the impact of war and exploring the question:

'Did WWI or WWII have the biggest impact on our locality?'

Geography

In Geography our unit focusses on protecting the environment and we will explore the question:

We will be focussing on developing composition and history of music through:

Through the study of these texts we will write a diary entry, bravery speech, a dual-narrative and persuasive letter.

Our focus for reading will be books about War, Traditional Tales and Poetry.

In grammar we will revise:

- Adverbials, subjunctive form and conjunctions and passive-voice

Art & Design/Design Technology

We will grow our knowledge and skills by:

- **Creating portraits** using drawing and collage techniques
- Creating and evaluating the design and structure of a **Chinese kite**.

Mandarin

We will be developing our written and spoken language this term with a focus on meeting and greeting

PSHE/Citizenship

We will understand the implications of **making online and in-app purchases** and understand how to **keep safe around water**.

Computing

Children will develop their computing skills through:

- Developing their own game
- Understand and evaluate systems and networks, in particular -search engines

Physical Education
