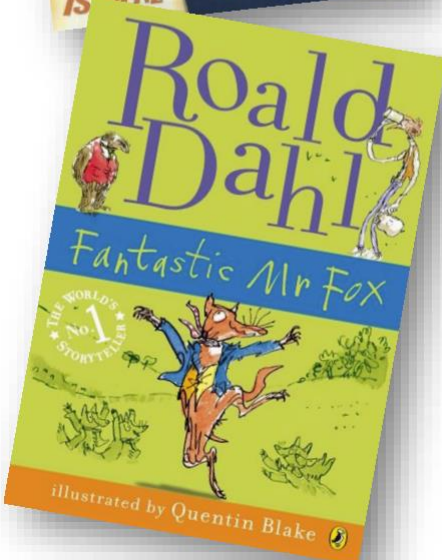


Bidston Avenue Reading Spine

In addition, each class in Key Stage 1 will also have a range of favourites read to them from the previous year. There is also opportunity for children to select their own to be read to the class.

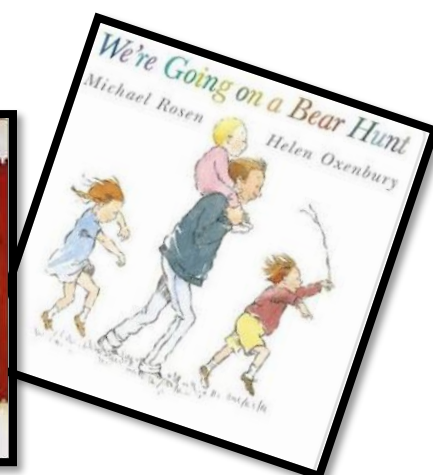
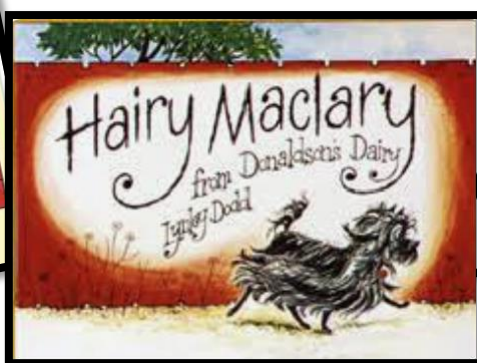
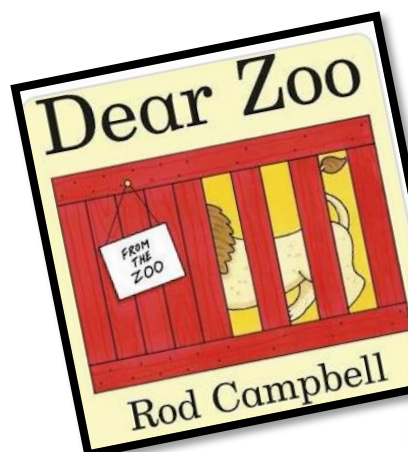
