



### Maths

This term, children will continue to develop their understanding of measure:

- **Length and temperature**
- **Volume and mass**
- **Money and time**

They will also continue to develop their 'resilience' and 'thinking' through problem solving and reasoning.

### History

- In this unit, the children will explore the key features of **The Bronze and Iron Ages**, comparing which period was the most impressive.
- They will then discover **The Romans** and learn why they invaded and settled in Britain.

### Geography

This term children will develop their locational knowledge by using their skills to answer the question:

**'Why do people live near Volcanoes?'**

### Art & Design/Design and Technology

We will grow our knowledge and skills by:

- Using **paint and stitch** to explore the theme 'land/water'
- Design and **build mini-greenhouses**

### Computing

Children will develop skills in two units:

- **Researching** to collaborate and build a presentation
- **Using emails** to communicate and how to stay safe online will be reinforced.

### Music

Children will continue with their Ukulele lessons.

### Religious Education Christianity

Children will explore ways in which The Bible is important for Christians.

### Physical Education

Two disciplines will be taught this term:
