



Maths

In Maths we will be building on our knowledge and understanding of the following:

- **Fractions** – adding and subtracting
- **Money and Time**
- **Decimals** – write tenths and hundredths, compare and make links with fractions

We will continue to build maths fluency by learning our times tables and apply the above skills to problem solving and reasoning in order to improve children's 'thinkina' and 'resilience'.

Music

We will be focussing on exploring pitch and volume and playing instruments using contrasting songs:

- **'Stop' – a song/rap about bullying**
- **'Lean on Me' - Soul/Gospel Song by Bill Withers**

Mandarin

We will gain knowledge in

- Chinese culture – why and how Chinese people celebrate New Year
- Naming body parts, animals and colours

PSHE/Citizenship

In our units this term we will learn about:

- Growing and changes we go through

In Science we will be growing our skills in 'working scientifically through the following units:

- **States of matter**- compare and group materials together, according to whether they are solids, liquids or gases.
