We will be travelling by bus, leaving school at **9:15am** and returning by **2:30pm**, in time for normal collection at the end of the school day.

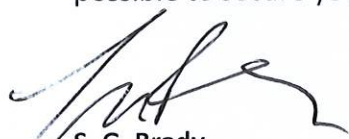
The cost of the trip is **£8** per child (**£5** for Pupil Premium children), payable via **ParentPay**.
