Year 3 class was learning about addition and subtraction of 3-digit numbers, breaking them down into hundred, tens and ones. The Year 4 class was learning about decimals and fractions. They also recapped the previous day's lesson. They made use of a counting stick and ice cube trays and counters. | |
